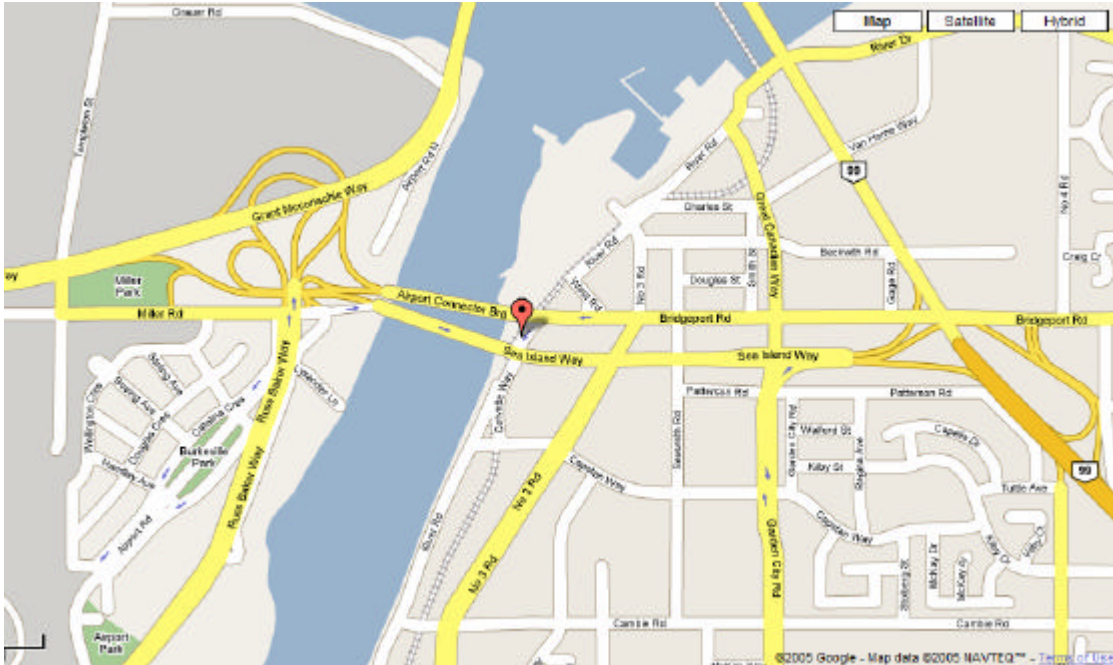

- How does it work?** If you have “**Stuff**” to “**Sell**,” it should be **nautical** in nature! You must bring your “**Stuff**” to be catalogued by 17:00 on “Sale Day”, or let us know as early as possible.
- What Time?** The Auction Starts at 19:00 **promptly!**
- What will it cost?** The normal \$5.00 entrance fee, plus 10% of whatever you sell.
(You may donate 100% of your sale on any or all of your items.)
- What kind of “Stuff”** Smaller items sell best. We generally find that huge costly items don’t auction well, but it is a good opportunity to tell people about them. (We ask that if something sells outside the auction, you donate 10% to the Squadron.)
- What else?** You will be provided with a bidding paddle, which will be your **buyer** number and also **seller** number. (Please don’t lose or mutilate this!)
